# What are “Historic Permits”?

***Permits files with permit numbers from 2007 or earlier, with a surety balance greater than \$0***


- Term “historic permits” stems from the 2011-08 Resolution
- Last update to the Board was 2015

# Renewed Focus with Unresolved Permits

What are “Unresolved Permits”?

***Permit files from all years, with a surety balance  
greater than \$0***

- Permits with surety are the **highest priority**
- Considers all permits
- Working to resolve the old, while still maintaining focus on recent



# Open Permits with Surety

*\*As of 2/5/24*

- **337 open permits with surety**
- **223 *current cycle* open permits with surety**
  - **“Current cycle” = permits issued from 2020-2024**
- Approx. half presumed "active" with a status of *Issued, Amended Issued, CAPROC, Amended CAPROC, or Post-Issued Amended CAPROC*

# Open Permits with Surety

*\*As of 2/5/24*


- Of all 337 open permits, approx. **\$1,816,926 in cash surety**
- Of 223 open “current cycle” permits, approx. **\$930,526 in cash surety**
- 2020-2024 permits in current cycle account for \$886,400 of current cash surety

# "Heavy Hitters"


- Bigger projects = more cash surety required
- **\$886,400** cash surety held in current cycle permits
- **\$83,800** surety make up 5 "heavy hitters" example
- ***A few large projects can disproportionately contribute to overall surety***


# Surety Held from 2004 -2011, Then




## Surety Held from 2004-2011, Today






### Closed Permits 2004-2011, Then

# New Hire Accomplishments

- Reviewed over 600 permits
- Created the “All Surety/Historic Permits” Summary Report
- Created *Assigned Inspector* field

# "Stop the bleeding"

- Maximize value of post-construction efforts
- Effort and cost increase as project extends
- Prioritizing compliance review
  - Low priority – minor changes, margin of error
  - Medium priority – variation from plan design; case-by-case
  - High priority – likely to have resource impact; request additional info

- Searchable record of permit description, contacts, review status, correspondence, inspections, surety and fee, any WCA rules, and BMPs
- Create custom searches and reports
- Generates automatic reminders


